BALLOT BOX - CHANGE TO BYLAWS

As you may already know, a vote will be taken at our annual meeting regarding membership dues. It will be decided at this meeting whether **all** members of the Senior Center should pay **\$12 yearly**; or if those who became **members prior to January 1, 2023** should be grandfathered at the **lifetime fee of \$5 they paid when they joined**.

We want your voice to be heard, but we also know it isn't possible for everyone to be at this meeting. Therefore, you'll find ballots on the table at the Senior Center, and a locked ballot box where you can put your ballot once you've voted. Please be aware that you will need to sign your ballot, as only members can vote; and also to avoid duplication. If your ballot isn't signed, it will be voided.

Your vote will determine which change listed below goes into effect January 1, 2025.

CHANGE #1: Should bylaws be changed whereby members of the Castle Rock Senior Center prior to January 1, 2023 be grandfathered in at a \$5.00 lifetime membership fee.

OR

<u>CHANGE #2:</u> Should bylaws be changed whereby every member of the Castle Rock Senior Center pay \$12 yearly, due and payable on January 1 of each year.
